Margo Perkins opened the meeting at 2:02 p.m which took place online, using Zoom.

#### I. William F. Noli Award — Mike McColm

Mike McColm began the meeting by announcing there were 7 nominees for this year's Noli Award. Each District Coordinator received a PDF of nomination letters to review. Also, each district was given the opportunity to discuss who they nominated and why. Following the presentation of each nominee, District Coordinators were asked to vote for their top 5 nominees. Votes were submitted online and tallied.

#### II. <u>Curriculum Reports – Margo Perkins</u>

Margo Perkins stated there were no new courses, additional sites/sections of existing courses, and no course updates to discuss, this month.

#### III. Finance/Legislation/Other — Janet Sloan

Janet Sloan began by discussing a part of Governor Newsom's state budget, which included the Golden State Pathways Program. This is a one-time funding proposal of \$1.5 billion targeted at specific California pathways in need. An update on the program, with general information, was attached to the Agenda email. More details are expected soon. Another one-time budget proposal of \$500 million was made to support dual-enrollment programs. Legislation for AB 388, which would grant ROP instructors tenure after their second year, is still pending in Sacramento. If passed sometime between June and August, the legislation would take effect in January 2023.

Next, Janet discussed CTEIG funding which was submitted last June for the 2020-2021 school year. We are still waiting for information on the amount to be granted for members of our consortium. Because of the increased amount of CTEIG funding from the state legislature this year—going from \$150 million to \$300 million—CDE has reworked formulas to maximize dollars distributed to districts. There is a strong possibility our consortium will receive the full amount requested, which has never happened before! GANS will come out at the end of March, with allocation funding letters to our consortium following. These funds are required to be spent by December 31, 2023.

Finally, Janet reviewed the Follow-up Study Progress Report which was very successful in making contact with students/families this year. The data collected is now being tabulated for participating districts and should be made available soon, so you can meet the upload deadline of March 4, 2022.

Teresa Schneider reminded districts to submit any out-of-region capital outlay purchases to her by the end of February.

#### IV. Advisory Night – April 26, 2022 – Mike McColm

Mike McColm updated district coordinators regarding our in-person Advisory Night event at Clovis North High School, taking place at the end of April. The registration link is currently live on the Attendance site. Please encourage your instructors to begin registering themselves, as well as their advisors who will be attending.

#### V. <u>K12 Pathway Specialists Report – Kenny Lopez/Michelle Wong</u>

Kenny Lopez discussed meeting with 15 districts to go over the Unitrack program. Kenny reminded districts about applications for the program being open currently, with a deadline date of February 28, 2022.

#### VI. Fresno ROP Skills Challenge and Expo — Anthony Ayerza

Anthony Ayerza discussed this year's modified version of our Fresno ROP Skills Challenge, with approximately 15 project-based events taking place. Information regarding event specifics, locations and times will be available soon. Career Tech Expo is currently in the works and scheduled for March 16, 2022 at Veterans Memorial Stadium (Buchanan High School) in Clovis. More information to follow. (UPDATE: Expo has been cancelled but is expected to return in the fall.)

#### VII. <u>Other</u>

No other information was discussed.
