Margo Perkins opened the meeting at 2:03 p.m which took place online, using Zoom.

I. Curriculum Reports — Margo Perkins

Margo Perkins stated there were no new courses or additional sites/sections to discuss.

II. Finance/Legislation/Other — Janet Sloan

Janet Sloan gave an update on CTE Incentive Funds and mentioned an upcoming webinar regarding our financial report and the data needed by January. Members of our consortium must submit their data to our office by January 17, 2023. We will report your financial expenditures. As a reminder, all 2021 CTEIG funds must be spent by December 2022.

Janet mentioned the California Department of Education is finally getting involved in the Community Classroom fingerprinting issue and there is a survey they developed for district input. Districts were asked to participate in the survey, so the CDE will have input regarding this widespread issue, as they work toward submitting changes through an urgency bill in Sacramento. The legislature won't hear any bills until the third week in February. If passed, the changes would take place immediately, and we wouldn't have to wait until July 1 to implement.

Janet said the Statewide Advisory Committee Meetings will be held at 1:00 p.m. on the last day (Tuesday, February 28) of the Educating for Careers Conference in Sacramento. If you're attending and would like to assist with these industry partner meetings, please contact Janet.

Finally, Janet requested districts turn in their District Agreement so Teresa Schneider can send their financial workbook. Also, first quarter claims were due at the end of October.

III. K12 SWP Pathway Coordinators — Kenny Lopez & Michelle Wong

Kenny Lopez shared that Cal-PASS+ data uploads were due November 1, but districts may still upload their data over the next few days. Michelle Wong mentioned Round 5 submissions were still being read and awards should be going out mid-December.

Melissa Murphy from IMAGO is available to help districts who have instructors working on the certificate for Leadership Alternate Strategy modules. Also, there may be additional modules for a second certificate coming soon. Please contact Kenny or Michelle for more info.

IV. Advisory Committee Meetings — Mike McColm

Mike McColm reminded District Coordinators that the fall Advisory Committee Meeting minutes and sign-in sheets are due to our office by December 16, 2022. Also, the William F. Noli Award nominations are due by January 9, 2023. Please refer to the attached submission guidelines for specific details and share with your instructors. This year, the awards will be presented at our spring Advisory Night event to be held for the first time at CTEC on April 20, 2023.

V. Career Tech Expo Recap — Anthony Ayerza

Anthony Ayerza thanked districts for their participation in this year's Career Tech Expo event at Chukchansi Park. Over 1,900 students and 80 business partners attended the event, and our main sponsor, Chevron, was impressed with the turnout and event itself. Business partners that were a part of our student experiences were very pleased with the students districts sent. Kenny Lopez mentioned several students received job offers, following their participation in this year's event.
